The Institute for Transportation Research and Education (ITRE) is seeking interns this summer for the 2025 North Carolina Observational Seatbelt Study. Interns will gain experience in field work and data collection by observing seatbelt usage on roads across the state.

- Travel all over the state!
- Up to 40 hours of work per week.
- Weekend hours and overnight travel may be required.
- Self-scheduling system.
- No set contract length, will end once seatbelt study is over around mid summer semester.
- Additional paid office work may be available nearing end of study.
- Must be willing to collect data outside in summer weather conditions.
- Work days will typically be 12 hours long, most of which is driving.
- Must be able to get yourself to and from centennial campus for shifts.
- Apply for position of Safety Officer or Data Collector:

Safety Officers:

- **\$17 / hour pay**
- Valid driver's license by start date
- Must be comfortable driving other participants in a state-owned vehicle

Data Collectors:

- **\$15 / hour pay**
- Must be 18 years or older
