The **O**ncology-focused **P**ostdoctoral **T**raining **I**n **C**are **D**elivery and **S**ymptom **S**cience (OPTICS) training program will train postdoctoral fellows to conduct research aligned with one or more of four thematic areas related to innovative care delivery: 1) Data Science, 2) Risk Mitigation, 3) Symptom Science, and 4) Care Delivery over a two year period.

The OPTICS Program aims to train researchers to:

- Acquire expertise in research methods
- Complete an original research study with close mentorship from program faculty
- Develop core professional skills necessary to launch a career in cancer-focused population science
